

A Project Delivery Team is being assembled to assist the Natural Resource Management Career Development Steering Committee, (NRMCDSC), in the development of new scenarios for the exportable training program, Safe Self. The PDT is asking for suggested topics to be submitted to Bill Jackson by March 1, 2004. Below is the format in which the suggested scenarios should be submitted:

Examples:

1. **Scenario:** Project maintenance employee is trying to make an electrical repair at on occupied campsite.

**Setting:** Campsite with electric hookup.

**Players:** Camper and Corps maintenance employee

**Action:** Maintenance employee arrives and attempts to determine what the problem may be by interviewing the camper at the site.

2. **Scenario:** Theft of property

**Setting:** Boat launching ramp, parking area. Truck with a broken window.

**Players:** Fisherman/Park Ranger/Park Attendant/Park Host/Maintenance Employee

**Action:** Fisherman returns to the launching ramp after being out on the lake all morning fishing to discover his/her truck window has been broken and all the contents have been stolen. He/she flags down a (Corps employee or representative) to report the incident. The fisherman berates the (Corps employee or representative) for the lack of security in the parking area. He/she is upset because he/she has paid the launching fee which they feel should pay for providing secure environment for their belongings while out on the lake.

3. **Scenario:** Farmer realigning a tributary

**Setting:** Creek bank, backhoe tractor.

**Players:** Farmer/landowner, Corps representative (Regulatory Specialist, Park Ranger)

**Action:** Corps representative receives a phone call from an individual reporting their neighbor for digging in a tributary. Corps representative makes contact with the landowner while they are working in the stream.
