Summary

The purpose of the workshop was to build content for the Environmental Stewardship (ES) Special Status Species and Invasive, Exotic and Nuisance Species sections of the Natural Resource Management (NRM) Gateway. On day one of the workshop, an overview of the NRM Gateway Initiative was presented to workshop attendees. Bonnie Bryson and Angie Huebner provided background information about the Stewardship Advisory Team and a summary of work completed for the ES portion of the Gateway.
