

SUBJECT: Addition to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sign Standards Program –  
Approval of New Alternate Wording on Warning Sign

1. Upon the recommendation of the Sign Advisory Work Group and the National Sign Program Manager, an alternate wording to the WRN-21 sign reading: Warning / Water Quality Does Not Meet Safe Health Standards / Lake Closed has been approved and the alternate will be added to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sign Standards Manual (EP 310-1-6a and 6b).
