1. References:

b. CECW-ON Memorandum, dated 2 February 2001, subject: Natural Resource Management NRM Gateway Initiative - Content Subject Matter Experts (SME)

2. The referenced memorandum 1.a. requested each Division and District to nominate reviewers for this website, consisting of Division and District Office, as well as project level reviewers. These individuals will comprise the NRM Gateway Field Review Group (FRG). They will receive email communications periodically requesting they access and review the website and provide specific comments on site functionality and accessibility. Nominations submitted have been evaluated, and the selected FRG members are listed in Enclosure 1. These selections have been made contingent upon final approval by the nominee's supervisor. If any of the selected FRG members are not available for this assignment, request that the supervisor notify Ms. Judy Rice at CECW-ON.

NRM Gateway Initiative
Field Review Group (FRG) Protocol
March 2001

- Costs: Each FRG member's district is responsible for labor costs incurred for this initiative. No TDY requirements are anticipated.
- Equipment & software requirements: Each FRG member's district shall provide access to a PC typical of that used by NRM employees in the district represented, with Corps standard software and Internet access. This does NOT have to be a dedicated machine, as the NRM Gateway is to be designed for accessibility from any standard Corps PC.
- IM Support: If problems are experienced accessing the site, or if software (i.e., Adobe Reader) upgrades seem necessary to view content, each FRG member shall coordinate first with their local IM representative to resolve the issue. If the problem cannot be solved locally, contact the NRM Gateway Webmaster Ginny Dickerson.
- Estimate of Time involved, CY 2001:
 - March 2001: Make an initial, brief review to get familiar with the prototype website.
 - March/Early April 2001: Thoroughly review the site after notification that the webmaster has posted materials from the first content development workshop that was held in February 2001. Submit comments in time for review and action by the webmaster prior to the NRM Gateway "Grand Opening" at the National Natural Resources Management Conference to be held in Portland, Oregon, 17-19 April 2001.
 - May-July 2001: When notified that changes have been made, make a follow-up review of improvements to the site based on comments received by the FRG, as well as other feedback received after the grand opening.
 - August - October 2001: Thoroughly review the site after notification that the webmaster has posted materials from the second content development workshop to be held in July 2001. Submit comments in time for review and action by the webmaster prior to the November 2001 NRM Recreation Management Support Program meeting.
 - Quarterly or as-required review and update when notified that the webmaster has posted additional content or made significant format changes to the site.
- Length of Commitment:
 - Minimum of 1-year. Indefinite tenure.
