MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDERS, MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS

Subject: Nominations For Special Assignment – Corps Participation in 2005 National Scout Jamboree, Ft. A. P. Hill, Virginia

1. The 2005 National Scout Jamboree will be held at Ft. A. P. Hill, Virginia, on 25 July through 3 August 2005. The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers will participate in the Conservation/Environment Area by providing an agency exhibit as well as Corps team members to staff it.
2. Ten field park rangers are needed to staff the Corps exhibit and assist with other tasks within the Conservation/Environment Area. Please provide the names of two, or more, nominees from your Division to assist with this effort. Alternates will also be selected from this list. Corps team members must be available on site from 21 July through 4 August 2005, to assist with setting up and taking down the exhibit.
3. Primary consideration should be given to those who have not previously served in this capacity. Please use the following criteria as a guide in selecting your nominees.
 - a. GS-025-09 and above permanent employees.
 - b. Experience in dealing with youths
 - c. Background in interpretive services
 - d. Experience in Scouting as an adult
 - e. Training in Scout adult leadership
4. I would appreciate your personal attention in the selection of these individuals. We want the best people the Corps has to offer for this effort since the Corps exhibit will be visited by 45,000 Jamboree participants and several thousand additional visitors. Duties will involve the direct interpretation to youth and adults, manual labor, a large amount of walking, working outside in hot and dusty conditions for up to 10 hours per day while in the Corps park ranger uniform, and dealing with a large number of visitors daily. Travel, per diem, and salary costs will be the responsibility of each home office. Overtime should be authorized for all participants.
5. Please provide the names of your nominees and a resume of their background and experience based on the criteria provided above. Any additional information you wish to supply will also be helpful. My point of contact for this effort is Mr. Terry Ramsey, Operations Manager, W.
