SUBJECT: Request for Nominations for the American Recreation Coalition's Legends Award

1. The American Recreation Coalition (ARC) wishes to honor an outstanding U.S. Army Corps of Engineers employee with their 2007 Legends Award. This award is presented annually to recognize an outstanding individual for his/her significant contributions to the enhancement of outdoor recreation resources, facilities, and experiences on the nation's public lands. The award winner will be recognized during Great Outdoors Week (11 - 15 June 2007) at a special luncheon ceremony in Washington, D.C. where the award will be presented.
2. Any individual employed by the Corps is eligible to receive the ARC Legends Award. Please submit one nomination per Major Subordinate Command not later than 6 April 2007. The nomination should describe the significant personal contributions the nominee has made enabling others to enjoy quality recreational experiences in our great outdoors.
3. Nominations for the Legends Award will be evaluated based upon the individual's extensive and innovative performance using the enclosed selection criteria (Encl 1).
4. MSC Commanders should forward their nomination along with supporting documentation, as described in Enclosure 2, to Mr. Jeffrey Pobiegló, Natural Resources Management CoP. He is my point of contact on this matter and may be reached at (202) 761-4559.

**AMERICAN RECREATION COALITION
LEGENDS AWARD**

Purpose and Selection Criteria

The American Recreation Coalition annually recognizes one individual from each major recreation-related federal agency during Great Outdoors Week, held in June in Washington, D.C. The awards are presented to recognize extraordinary individual efforts that have expanded and enhanced recreational opportunities through public/private partnerships, or have increased participation in outdoor recreation through innovative programs based upon public/private partnerships. Selection of the agency recipient is the responsibility of each participating agency. Award criteria include:

- 1) Quantifiable improvements in either:
 - a) recreation opportunities (services and/or facilities); or
 - b) participation in recreation by one or more categories of the American public labeled “non-traditional visitors.”

Maximum points: 30

- 2) Reliance upon partnerships with for-profit and nonprofit organizations in the private sector.

Maximum points: 30

- 3) Use of creative solutions and programs, and demonstrated efforts to share news of creative solutions within the agency.

Maximum points: 20

- 4) Community support for the work of this individual, as reflected in awards, roles on community boards and committees, etc.

Maximum points: 20

The recognition process will be conducted in two phases. Phase One will involve showcasing the Legends Award winners at the Sheldon Coleman Great Outdoors Award Celebration. Phase Two, the actual recognition ceremony, will take place during a special function featuring key officials from the Executive Branch.

**Supporting Documentation
American Recreation Coalition Legends Award
for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Nominee**

Nominations will be evaluated on the basis of content that should concisely describe specific accomplishments.

To assist with the evaluation process and award presentation, the following must be included with the nomination submission:

1. A three-page description of the nominee's achievements. Margins will be 1-inch and print type will be Times New Roman, 12 point.
2. A proposed citation that may be read at the award ceremony.
3. A 100-word summary of the achievement of the individual suitable for use in preparing a news release.
4. A color, digital photograph of the nominee in high resolution suitable for publication.
5. A color, 8" x 10" photo of the nominee suitable for framing.

The entire nomination package will not exceed five pages.
