## Description

Hales Landing is located off of Ten Mile Still Road approximately two miles from the intersection with State Highway 263. Hales Landing is approximately 4 miles south of Bainbridge, Georgia. Hales Landing public use area provides picnicking and camping, waterborne toilet and showers\*, a boat ramp with car/trailer parking, courtesy dock, access to prime fishing waters on the Flint River arm of Lake Seminole, and access to the adjoining wildlife management area land managed by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources.

\* A fire of unknown origin destroyed the waterborne toilet and shower facility in September 1999. Due to funding limitations, this facility has yet to be replaced and a temporary chemical toilet has been installed. Therefore, the use of this area has been limited to day use only until a replacement facility can be constructed.

## Management Prescription

Proposed rehabilitation and improvements will separate day use and camping areas. They include construction of a RV dump station, two gates, gatehouse, two camper washhouses, fish cleaning facility, group picnic shelter, entrance sign, pave and resurface roads and parking areas, and install underground power and water lines to serve 68 plus class A campsites.

## Description

Spring Creek Landing is located approximately one mile off Spring Creek Road (State Highway 263) and is approximately 10 miles west of Bainbridge, Georgia. Spring Creek Park is located on the Spring Creek arm of Lake Seminole. This facility is located close to a concession providing gas, a supplies/bait store lodging, and covered boat storage. The park contains a large group picnic shelter and a number of picnic tables. The ramp parking lot can accommodate large fishing tournaments.

## Management Prescription

Add an additional launch ramp to accommodate the visitation from the adjacent concessionaire and to take advantage of the large parking area. A portion of this area has been closed due to lack of visitation. This portion consists of a group picnic shelter, several picnic sites and paved road surface. Plans for this area are on hold at this time and no future development is anticipated.

## Description

Rays Lake is located off Spring Creek Road (State Highway 253) approximately 8 miles south of Donaldsonville, Georgia. A large group picnic shelter, pit toilets, launch ramp with car/trailer parking and courtesy dock presently serve the park. This area attracts swimming at the boat ramp, which is causing safety concerns.

## Management Prescription

Proposed facility rehabilitation includes construction of 2 large waterborne toilets, a group picnic shelter, boat ramp and courtesy dock, pave and resurface roads and parking areas, and as a safety measure, develop a designated swimming area/beach in order to attract swimming activities away from the boat ramp.

Seminole Lodge is an outgrant concession lease with two boat-launch ramps, covered boat docks, marine fuel, bait and tackle store, camping with electrical hook-ups, and motel accommodations adjacent to Sneads Park on the south. The concessionaire's future plans include adding a restaurant. Three Rivers State Park is adjacent to Sneads Park on the north. Sneads Park is a day use area with two group picnic shelters, swim area, playground equipment, and boat launching ramp. Significant visitation is from the Sneads and Jackson County community. Much of the park area is open space with open field and grass land. The shoreline is susceptible to erosion from wave action from the lake in areas without sheet pile seawalls or shoreline protection.

## Management Prescription

Continued upgrading and improvement of the park is of high priority with this project due to its popularity with the people of Sneads, Florida and outside visitors.
