MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDERS, MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS  
AND DISTRICT COMMANDS

SUBJECT: National Review and Ranking of FY 2002 Recreation Area Modernization Program (RAMP) Proposals

1. References:

- a. CECW-O/CECW-B MEMO dated 18 April 2000, SUBJECT: The Recreation Area Modernization Program.
- b. EC 11-2-179, Appendix B-4, Construction General-Recreation Modernization.

2. Reference 1.a. and 1.b. required the submission of MSC ranked RAMP proposals for HQUSACE review.

3. Reference 1.b. stated that HQUSACE would convene a meeting of MSC representatives to prioritize the MSC proposals from a national perspective. That meeting occurred on 31 July – 2 August 2000, here at HQUSACE

4. I believe that you have informally been made aware that the House and the Senate have chosen not to include funding for the RAMP program in the FY 2001 appropriation because it is a new start. No new starts were included in Committee Recommendations for the Corps. An opportunity to add funding during floor action or conference exists but I am not optimistic that this will occur.

5. In addition, we plan to include \$50 million for the RAMP program in the FY 2002 HQUSACE recommendations for the President's budget. In view of the possibility of funding being added at a later date I decided to move forward with the ranking process.

6. Since funding is in doubt for the FY 2001 RAMP program, I decided to place the 17 areas selected for FY 2001 at the top of the list for whenever initial funding is provided. These proposals are shown on the enclosure. Assuming that our budget amount of \$50 million is appropriated, our plan is to fund these proposals to the \$50 million level or to whatever level of funding that is provided. You will note that the proposals are listed by state and are not in rank order. The proposals not listed on the enclosure are being held for later review.
