

SUBJECT: Addition to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sign Standards Program - Approval
of New Danger Sign

Upon the recommendation of the Sign Advisory Work Group and the National Sign Program Manager, a sign reading: Danger/Steep Drop-offs/Strong Currents has been added to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Signs Standards Manual (EP 310-1-6a and 6b).
