The National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) Coach Assist and Train Team (CATT) was established in 2000 to help assist and provide support to the field in the operations and maintenance of those components of the NRRS field operations not supported by the reservation contractor. Under the new NRRS contract and ORMS operating system, the current NRRS CATT is being restructured to better support the field under ORMS.

By NLT 15 March 2008 please submit a nominate, for each district participating in the NRRS, through the representative MSC to Diane Stratton, NRRS CATT Leader.

This can be a current CATT member or someone new. If you feel a district needs two members then nominate two with justification. Nominees must be individuals with some computer knowledge of hardware and software and willing to share information across their district. The District will be responsible for travel and labor for nominees submitted to represent their district. CATT members will work under the direction of the Corps NRRS Program Manager and COTR and CATT Leader when performing as a member of a CATT.

Once all nomination have been received, nominations will be confirmed and Diane will schedule a training session for all CATT team members in April.

If you are not sure who the past or current CATT members are, you can go out to the gateway on the CATT page and look under the CATT tab.

This new CATT is being restructured to develop trained personnel within each District who can assist their own team members in resolving NRRS ORMS Field Manager connectivity, software and hardware issues not supported by the reservation contractor. It's critical we maintain this support and restructure the team to meet future needs and expectations.
