A special event permit is hereby granted for the period of _____ that is revocable at
will by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and subject to the following conditions:

1. That the exercise of the privileges hereby granted will be under the general supervision of the Operations Manager and Park Manager and subject to federal rules and regulations including Title 36, Chapter III, Part 327 of the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations (a copy is enclosed).
2. This permit is issued subject to the laws of _____ Parish. Any state and/or local permits, if required, must be obtained by the permittee prior to Corps approval.
3. That any property of the United States damaged or destroyed by the permittee will be promptly repaired or replaced by the permittee to the satisfaction of the Operations Manager or Park Manager or in lieu of replacement or repair, pay to the United States money in an amount sufficient to compensate for the loss sustained by the United States by reason of damage to or destruction of government property.
4. That the United States will not be liable for damages to property or injuries to persons that may arise from or be incident to the exercise of the privileges herein granted, or for damages to the property of the permittee, or for injures to the person of the permittee, or for damages to the property or injuries to the person of the permitted officers, agents, servants, or employees or others who may be on said premises at their invitation or the invitation of any one of them, and the permittee will hold the United States harmless from any and all such claims arising from the negligence of the United States.
5. That the United States will not be liable for damages to property or injuries to persons which may arise from or be incident to the construction, maintenance and use of the facilities constructed by the permittee on the said premises.
6. It is understood that participants are responsible for their own sewerage and garbage disposal. Upon completion of the day's activities, the area will be policed and cleared of all debris.
7. That the permittee will exercise due care in the use of the premises so as to minimize the impact on environmental and cultural resources.
8. Private use of the project lands will not preempt public use of project recreational resources. A majority of project facilities will remain available to the general public.

9. Admission to view the event will be open to the general public without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age. Participation in the event may be limited to members of the sponsoring group provided that the group does not unlawfully discriminate against participation in the event on grounds of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age. Request for special event permits citing “special circumstances” for participation requiring gender or age discrimination must be accompanied by an exceedingly persuasive justification. This may be appropriate for activities such as contact sports and sports such as tennis, golf or competitive swimming. Fishing tournaments do not qualify for discrimination based on gender.

10. The permittee will provide proof of liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 (one million dollars) for the special event prior to issuance of this permit.

11. The Government reserves the right to refuse or cancel any event or program at any time before or during the event as determined by the Operations Manager or Park Manager, without liability to the Government or its employees.

12. That permission is granted to use the site only on the dates indicated above. Any additional requests for use of Corps areas for special activities must be received at least 60 days in advance.
