The National Park Service initiates a print order with GPO each year for all the Federal agencies for the subject materials. The Corps rides the print order for our requirements. This is normally done in the November/December time frame to assure supplies are adequate for the next recreation season.

This year the NPS was delayed in placing their print order. It was finally placed this week, along with our riders for our requirements. The estimated delivery date is 4 - 6 weeks from now - or near the end of June. The materials will be shipped directly to the OCE Publications Depot, which will fill your orders as soon as possible - including all current back orders.

Because of this delay and the problems it has caused this year, I increased our order significantly above what we ordered last year. In the past, projects submitted their estimated requirements through the NRMS. In the future, field offices will submit their requirements for these materials in OMBIL.

I will send an Email to you when the materials have arrived at the Depot.
